


How to Begin or Resume an Online Course

1. Go to www.asrm.org and click “Log In” (located in the upper right corner on a desktop computer).
2. On the “My ASRM” homepage, log in to your account.
3. Once you have logged in (or completed the account registration process), hover over the “Learn” tab and click on “My Courses.” **Click here to learn how to register for a course.**
